## Campaign Surpasses \$600 Million Milestone



Your generosity has helped Drexel break a new record in fundraising and brought us more than three-quarters of the way toward our \$750 million goal. Together with your fellow supporters, you are expanding Drexel's capacity to prepare students for academic and professional success, generate research and innovation that addresses urgent societal challenges, and sustain civic engagement initiatives that benefit the Philadelphia community and beyond.

Of the \$615 million raised during the Campaign, the overall progress on select priorities includes:

- **\$135 million** for research initiatives
- **\$128 million** for academic support

**\$119 million** for scholarships and co-op

- **\$34 million** for civic engagement
- **\$29 million** for endowed professorships and chairs
